**NARRATIVE**

On the above listed times, I observed Brandon Deleon and Brian Yerdon (arrestees) along with other males outside of the Boston Market located at 16251 W Dixie Hy. Brandon and Brian appeared to be involved in a verbal argument and appeared to be intoxicated aswell. The males then decided to enter the restaurant and gather by the entrance. Brandon and Brian were carrying on with their argument inside the restaurant causing other patrons to stare and be concerned with their safety. On several occasions Brandon and Brian looked over at myself and other officers but ignored our presence and continued to use profanity and disturb the business. Since they were standing by the doorway, other patrons were prevented from leaving or entering the restaurant. At this time, Brandon looked over at the officers and yelled "Fuck You" holding his middle finger at our direction. Myself and other officers then rushed over to Brian and Brandon and escorted them outside. While escorting Brandon outside, I advised him that he was under arrest for disorderly conduct. At this point, Brandon became irate and advised me the he was not going to be arrested. Using a modified armbar technique, I was able to direct Brandon to the ground where he tensed his body and clenched his fists in attempts to avoid being handcuffed. Loud verbal commands were given for Brandon to allow me to handcuff him. Subsequently he became tired and was handcuffed. Brandon was placed inside my police car along with Brian who was also under arrest by Ofc. Ruiz. On the drive to the station, Brandon begun to slam his head against the plexi glass numerous times while he yelled "I'm going to eat you". Once at the station, rescue was called to treat the abrasions that Brandon had caused on himself.

Aerial 31 Lt. Berner responded and attempted to treat Brandon. While taking his blood pressure, Brandon launched to bite Ofc. Ruiz which was the closest to him. Brandon growled and opened and closed his jaw slamming his teeth like an animal would. Brandon was taken to the ground and handcuffed then placed into cell #2. While inside the cell, Brandon begun to act in a very bizarre and strange manner by barking and growling at the officers and fire personnel through the glass. He repeatedly slammed his head on the glass and yelled with such energy to alarm and create the concern of Lt. Berner and ourselves that he was under some type of dangerous narcotic that made him act in such a violent manner. In fear that Brandon would injure himself further, Officers had to enter the cell and use leg restraints in order to place him on the gurney for transport. Brandon had to be given a spit/bite mask because he continued to attempt to bite and spit at officers and fire personnel near him. Rescue 31 responded and transported Brandon to the Aventura Hospital for further treatment and drug testing.

When arrested, Brandon was in possession of a drink called "FOUR LOKO" which is a combination of energy and 12% alcohol by volume. He also had an almost empty bottle of rum. It was later discovered that Brandon was also under the influence of a new recreational drug called "Cloud 9" which is an incense type substance that can be smoked like marijuana and achieve numerous levels of impairment.

Brandon remains at the Aventura Hospital under arrest until released by a Doctor in the morning. Brandon`s blood test revealed: Cannabis, alcohol level of 290 and Xanax.
